*If you are required to obtain a permit or register with the City, that permit or registration must be displayed on your outer clothing while going door to door.

**Cannot knock on the door at the premises of any property that has posted signs signaling that you are not invited (ex. “No Trespassing” or “No Soliciting”) or the address of the property is located on the City’s Do No Knock Registry List.

***Can only conduct these activities between 9:00am-8:00pm, unless by appointment or invitation.

If you violate any of these requirements and any other requirements of Chapter 745, you are subject to criminal citation.
